It is my pleasure to present a report of the College activities of the academic year 2014-15.

Management:

The College is sponsored by the Academy of Liberal Education (Regd.), Sullia under the dynamic leadership of Dr. Kurunji Venkatramana Gowda, the Founder President of the Academy and presently run under the dedicated and devoted team of Managing Committee led by Dr. K.V. Chidananda, who have been instrumental in providing a beautiful renovated building at an estimated cost of three crores making provisions for independent subject-wise staff rooms, sports & games, NCC, NSS, Science Laboratories and even Computer Browsing Centre. Our Kudos and compliments to Dr. K.V. Chidananda and all members of the Managing Committee.

Courses Offered:

The College has been re-assessed & accredited itself with 'A' Grade by the NAAC for a period of five years in the month of September 2012. It offers courses in Humanities, Commerce, Science, Social Work and Management Studies catering to the needs of the local students. We have also introduced the M.S.W. course during the year 2010-11.

The College is enjoying permanent affiliation to B.A, B.Com and B.Sc. Degree courses of Mangalore University. It has been included under Section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act of 1956. With the financial assistance of the UGC, we have improved our infrastructure especially, library, laboratory and teaching facilities for the benefit of the students.

In the year 2014-15 we have received grant of ` 10,55,000 under the XII plan scheme for Library books and Laboratory equipment and IQAC. An additional grant of ` 22,05,000 has also been sanctioned towards equipment.

Karnataka State Open University, Mysore has sanctioned Study Centre for B.A and B.Com courses to our College from the academic year 2012-13. Mr. Shridhar is the Coordinator for the same.
