Management:

The College is sponsored by the Academy of Liberal Education (Regd.), Sullia, under the able leadership of Late Dr. Kurunji Venkatramana Gowda, the Founder President of the Academy and presently run under the dynamic leadership of Dr. K.V. Chidananda sir, who has been instrumental in creating a academic ambience by providing required infrastructure both for academic and non academic activities in the college and also providing for a beautiful renovated building at an estimated cost of more than Rs. Three crores, making provisions for independent subject-wise staff rooms, sports & games, NCC, NSS, Science Laboratories with internet connections and Computer Browsing Centre. All the class rooms, library, laboratories staffrooms, office, open spaces are covered under CCTV surveillance. Our heartfelt reverence to Dr. K.V. Chidananda sir and all the members of the Managing Committee.

Courses Offered:

The College has been re-assessed & re-accredited in the month of September 2012 with 'A' Grade by the NAAC for a period of five years. It offers courses in Humanities, Commerce & Management, Science and Social Work catering to the needs of the local students. We have also introduced the M.S.W. course during the year 2010-11. We have two sections in Commerce degree course.

The College is enjoying permanent affiliation to B.A, B.Com and B.Sc. Degree courses of Mangalore University. It has been included under Section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act of 1956. With the financial assistance of the UGC, we have improved our infrastructure especially, library, laboratory and teaching facilities for the benefit of the students. In the year 2014-15 we have received grant of Rs.10,55,000.00 under the XII plan scheme for library books, laboratory equipment and IQAC.

KSOU Study Centre:

Karnataka State Open University, Mysore has sanctioned Study Centre for B.A and B.Com courses to our College from the academic year 2012-13. Mr. Shridhar V, Lecturer in Commerce, is the coordinator of KSOU.
