### Management:

The College is sponsored by the Academy of Liberal Education (Regd.), Sullia, under the able leadership of Late **Dr. Kurunji Venkatramana Gowda**, the Founder President of the Academy and presently run under the dynamic leadership of **Dr. K.V. Chidananda sir**, who has been an instrumental in creating a academic ambience by providing required infrastructure both for academic and non academic activities in the college and also providing for a beautiful renovated building at an estimated cost of more than three crores, making provisions for independent subject-wise staff rooms, sports & games, NCC, NSS, Science Laboratories with internet connections and Computer Browsing Centre. All the class rooms, library, laboratories staff rooms, office, open spaces are covered under CCTV surveillance and Public address system. Our heartfelt reverence to **Dr. K.V. Chidananda sir** and all the members of the Managing Committee.

## **Courses Offered**:

The College has been re-assessed & re-accredited for the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle in the month of September 2012 with 'A' Grade by the NAAC and we have submitted the SSR to NAAC for 3<sup>rd</sup> Cycle and the NACC Peer Team is going to visit on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of this month.. The College offers courses in Humanities, Commerce, Management, Science and Social Work catering to the needs of the local students. We have introduced the M.S.W. course during the year 2010-11 and M.Com in the year 2017-18. We have two sections in Commerce degree course.

The College is enjoying permanent affiliation to B.A, B.Com and B.Sc. Degree courses of Mangalore University. It has been included under Section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act of 1956. With the financial assistance of the UGC, we have improved our infrastructure especially, library, laboratory and teaching facilities for the benefit of the students. In the year 2014-15 we have received grant of Rs.10,55,000.00 under the XII plan scheme for library books, laboratory equipment and IQAC.

### **Staff:**

There are 58 teaching and 15 non-teaching staff serving in the Institution with utmost devotion and dedication. **Sri Somashekara K.H.**, Watchman and **Smt. Kamalakshi D.C.** Clerk cum Typist have retired from their services on attaining superannuation in the month of January and February 2018. The College is grateful for the services rendered by them.

The present strength of the College in the UG and PG course is 836 (348 Male and 488 Female).
